



Dorothy Court was born Clara Dorothy Court.

Dorothy Court's first appearance on the London Stage was in a 1903 at the Court theatre in a production of The Tempest.

Primarily she was a concert singer and was engaged by the D'Oyly Carte Opera Company in 1908.

Her roles were as:

Josephine in H.M.S. Pinafore in September 1908

Celia in Iolanthe, October 19, 1908

Mabel in The Pirates of Penzance, December 1, 1908

Casilda in The Gondoliers, January 18, 1909

After leaving the D'Oyle Carte company Dorothy toured Australia with the Williamson Company in The King of Cadonia and The Dollar Princess. On her return to England she performed primarily on the variety and concert stages. Many of her popular songs were composed by her husband, Haydn Wood.
